- c. Ensure all creatives and directions are sent through email and social media to all your schools and educational administrators through your office, and through schools to all parents/students.
- d. Ensure maximum registration by students of Schools/Institutions under your Department in the online creative writing competition being conducted at https://innovateindia.mygov.in/ppc-2023/ from 25th November, 2022 to 30th December, 2022 to avail of the chance of being selected for this event.
- e. The following hashtag is to be used for disseminating this event: #PPC2023.
- f. Request Schools/Institutions under your Ministry to use their own social media handles and #PPC2023 to disseminate the event, along with their own preparations for the event. Schools could make their own posters/creatives/videos, etc. and post accordingly. The selected creatives/videos from among these shall also be exhibited on the MyGov platform.
- g. Students will be selected in States/UTs for receiving special PPC Kits. States have been requested to issue instructions to SCERT or equivalent organization in the States/UTs, to carry out the selection process subject to allocated quota (Annexure-I) in coordination with NCERT.

2. Our culture is our pride (हमारी संस्कृति हमारा गर्व)

What is special about your state's culture? What elements of that culture make you feel proud of your country?

3. My book my inspiration (मेरी प्रिय किताब)

Which is a book that has shaped you greatly and why?

4. Save Environment for future generations (आने वाली पीढ़ियों के लिए पर्यावरण सुरक्षा)

What are your ideas about sustainable development? What challenges, do you anticipate for our future generation due to climatic changes? What measures must we take to protect our environment? How can you contribute in the sustainable development as a student?

5. My life, my health (अच्छा स्वास्थ्य क्यों ज़रूरी है?)

Why is remaining healthy important? What do you do to remain in good health?

6. My startup dream (मेरा स्टार्टअप का सपना)

Entrepreneurship among students towards self-reliance for succeeding in life and at the same time contributing to the nation's economy and work culture is the need of the hour. What are your dreams about your own startup?
